DIRECTIONS

SHAKE WELL. Do not use while ignition system is turned on. Do not allow spray to contact hot metal surfaces. Apply CARB FREE to external linkages, continue to spray until clean. Spray to clean butterfly valve, moving it back and forth until it moves freely. Continue by cleaning choke plate, shaft and throat walls. Disconnect PCV valve from crankcase. Spray CARB FREE into PCV valve until clear liquid runs out of the opposite end. Wait for fumes to evaporate before starting engine. Do not allow spray to contact painted surfaces.
